GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Complete the coursework with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 with no individual course grade below a "B-."

Satisfactorily complete SSM 549: Sport Management Capstone.

Obtain recommendation for graduation from the program chair.

Satisfactorily complete all program requirements within seven consecutive academic years.

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AND MANAGEMENT

GRADING SYSTEM/ PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

CBM uses the quality point system defined by the University. Performance requirements are as follows:

Graduate students enrolled in a CBM master's degree program are required to maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0.

If a student's GPA falls below 3.0, he/she will be considered on "academic probation" and must re-establish a GPA of 3.0 within the next six graduate credits or face dismissal.

In the MBA program, no course grade lower than a "C" will be accepted for credit in a CBM graduate-level course. In the Management program, no course grade lower than a "B-" will be accepted for credit in a CBM graduate-level course. If a low grade is earned, the student is required to retake the course and repay the required tuition fee. The student must contact his/her Academic Advisor to make arrangements to retake the course in a timely manner. Receipt of three grades of B- or lower will result in dismissal from the University. See the "Academic Policies" section of the catalog for more information. Each course may be repeated only once, unless it is appealed to the program chair.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive a master's degree in the College of Business and Management, the following requirements must be met:

- All graduate coursework at Cardinal Stritch University has been completed with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (4.0 scale) or better.
- All Cardinal Stritch University coursework has been completed with no grade lower than a "C" counted toward the MBA degree; for the Management program, the minimum grade requirement is a "B-."
- All financial obligations to the University have been met.
- Student has successfully completed all program requirements.
- Faculty recommendation for graduation.
- All graduate credits applied to the degree must have been completed within seven (7) years of the time of graduation.

Application for graduation must be submitted by March 1 for May graduation, August 15 for August graduation, and by October 1 for December graduation. Formal commencement ceremonies are held in Milwaukee each May.
